
The Firm is now open! The third development created in downtown West Fargo on northern Sheyenne Street has opened. The Beacon has been approved for TIF financing. Grand Forks City Council members unanimously approved tax breaks for a redevelopment project at the Townhouse Hotel. The council's vote was the last that The Beacon needed to secure a "tax increment financing plan," which means the properties will be taxed at its existing property tax rate, rather than the much higher one it'd incur once they're completed.
